

Road FAQ's

Q. Can you blade our road?

A. Roosevelt County only maintains public roads on the county road inventory, and will not maintain private roads or driveways.

Q. Can you install a driveway culvert?

A. The Road Superintendant will inspect the property, and recommend the proper size culvert to the property owner. It is the responsibility of the property owner to purchase the culvert and materials to cover the culvert. Culverts can only be installed by the county road department.

Q. Who is responsible for repairing pot holes?

A. The Road department will repair/patch potholes on paved, county maintained roads. The Road department will grade caliche or dirt, county maintained roads.

Q. Why doesn't the road department blade roads immediately following rain?

A. Roads will be maintained after moisture has had time to soak in. The weight of the equipment causes ruts in the surface if the road is bladed too soon after a rain.
