

## ROOSEVELT COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSONERS RESOLUTION NO. 2025-06

## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE COUNTY'S POLICY TO RESPECT FEDERAL IMMIGRATION LAW

WHEREAS, several local governments around the United States have stated a policy to defy federal enforcement of immigration law; and

WHEREAS, illegal immigration presents dangers to the citizens and lawful immigrants of the United States, dangers that include drug trafficking, human trafficking, entry of violent criminal, and terrorism; and

WHEREAS, certain groups that advocate for illegal immigration have falsely included Roosevelt County as being a sanctuary county for illegal immigration; and

WHEREAS, Roosevelt County desires to state clearly its policy to respect federal law and cooperate with federal authorities regarding immigration law;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT ROOSEVELT COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS STATES THAT it shall be the policy of Roosevelt County to respect federal immigration law, and to cooperate fully with federal authorities in the enforcement of federal immigration law.
